

'Making Gardening Easier'



The Henley HandyBus has been serving people living in and around Henley for over 30 years. It helps people to get out and about, to meet their pals and to go shopping locally and twice a month to Reading.

The bus will collect you from your home and take you to various places in Henley on a daily basis. It carries all kinds of people including those with mobility difficulties and people who perhaps do not have transport or are unable to access regular busses. The bus carries wheelchairs and of course our drivers always help with heavy shopping bags and trolleys. There are many reasons why you may be eligible to use the bus. If you have a bus pass it's free. If you do not have one we can help you get one. If you are not eligible for a bus pass you can still use the bus as we make only a small charge. The bus can carry up to 14 passengers as well as one or two wheel chairs. The tail lift makes it easy to load wheel chairs or heavy shopping. Each day the bus has its regular duties which include shopping at Tesco and Waitrose. Every day it takes passengers to the 60+ Club in the town centre.

The bus also does various visits in the evenings and at weekends. For instance to garden centres, for coffee mornings and afternoon teas. In the Spring, Summer and Autumn we go to all kinds of venues. These are advertised on our website (**www.henleyhandybus.co.uk**) on the Outings page. We also advertise all of our routes and activities on the bus or you can make an enquiry by ringing **07597 124851**

The bus also provides a service every other Thursday evening to The Meteor Club (a Mencap charity) and on every other Thursday morning to the Stroke Club Art Class.

Waterperry Gardens.

This is always a popular visit. Eight acres of ornamental gardens and plant centre, cafe and much more. Entrance is £6.80. We always hear good reports of a visit to Waterperry. Leaving at 10am and returning for around 3 to 4pm. £8

Savill Garden, Windsor.

Renowned for the rhododendrons why not make a visit. Claimed to be England's finest garden, it covers 35 acres and contains the Oueens rose garden. Entry is £8.75. If the weather is kind it makes a wonderful trip. Leaving at 10am around 3pm. £8.

Notcutts Garden Centre.

Always interesting and a great cafe. Leaving at 2pm returning at 4.30pm. £6.

Afternoon tea at the Quince Tree in Stonor. Visit this lovely wooden building, have tea and browse in the fully stocked organic shop, full of treats. Leaving at 3pm, returning at 5pm. £4 (Thursday is a day when there isn't a lunch at 60+ Club)

Evening trip to the King William IV

Pub. In the village of Hailey nr Ipsden, with spectacular views the ride there is through the woods and lanes around Stoke Row. Leaving at 5.30pm we spend an hour at the King William IV before returning home. Good ales are always available. £4.

Toby Inn in Caversham.

'Home of the roast'. Choose from Pork, Beef or Turkey roast or Honey Glazed Gammon £6.99. Leave at 5.30pm, return at 8.30pm. £5. (Tuesday is a day when there isn't a lunch at 60+ Club)

Thame Market. Tuesday is market day in Thame. Set in the historic town centre browse to see what tempts you. There are lots of cafes and shops as well. The ride there is lovely and takes about 40 minutes. We will leave Henley at 11am and return by 3.30/4.00pm. £8 (has to be second & fourth Tuesday in the month to avoid the Reading shopping trip)

Salters steamer boat trip from Marlow to

Henley. We leave Henley at 12 noon for the ride to Marlow. The steamer leaves Marlow at 1pm and takes just over 2 hours to reach Henley. This is one of the finest stretches on the Thames. You can sit outside or inside and there is a nice little cafe and of course loos. When you reach Henley we will pick up to take you home in time for tea. The charge for the steamer is £11.90 and the HandyBus £5.

Bluebell Time.

Take a trip to see the wonderful bluebell woods at Nuffield Place. It's a flat easy walk...and have tea in Nettlebed on the way home. Leaving at 2pm. Returning at around 4.30pm. £4.
